The main concept

Ornina Syrian Orchestra is a beacon of cultural preservation and artistic excellence, dedicated to celebrating the rich musical heritage of Syria. Formed by a group of passionate Syrian musicians, the orchestra aims to revive and promote traditional Syrian music while also embracing contemporary compositions that reflect the dynamic spirit of Syrian culture.

Named after the ancient goddess of music and joy, Ornina, the orchestra embodies the timeless beauty and profound emotional depth of Syrian music. Through meticulously crafted performances, the orchestra showcases a diverse repertoire that spans centuries, from classical Arab melodies and traditional folk songs to innovative modern pieces.

The ensemble is composed of talented musicians who bring a wealth of experience and expertise, each contributing to a unique sound that resonates with audiences both in Syria and around the world. Their performances are not just concerts but cultural journeys that transport listeners to the heart of Syrian history and tradition.

Beyond their artistic endeavors, Ornina Syrian Orchestra is committed to fostering cultural exchange and understanding. They collaborate with international artists and participate in global festivals, spreading the message of peace, resilience, and the enduring power of music. Their work serves as a reminder of the unifying power of art, bridging cultural divides and fostering a deeper appreciation for Syrian musical heritage.

In every note they play and every song they sing, Ornina Syrian Orchestra tells the story of a vibrant and resilient culture, keeping the flame of Syrian music alive for future generations to cherish and enjoy.

The Orchestra

Ornina is an orchestra of classical and traditional Syrian music founded in 2016 as non profit association.

The professional Syrian artists who make up the orchestra, are for the most part old friends; each making their merry way across Europe, from Madrid to Stockholm and USA.

Some internationally renowned names in the world of classical music and opera stand out in this group, such as Shafi Badreddin, conductor and composer as well as sopranos Lubana Al Quntar and Rasha Rizk, who are both held in high regard by their peers, also the soloists Shadi Ali, Abo Gabi and Ali Asaad are another names on this prestigious list.

Shafi Badreddin at the head of the orchestra in his capacity as a composer, has longed to shake up traditional Eastern music to harmoniously integrate so-called Western instruments, such as the Horn or the Trombone.

The transcription put together by the maestro is accessible to even the most untrained ear.

A choir consists of a diverse group of Syrians, Arabs and Europeans who love music and singing Ornina offers them vocal training with professional singers from the orchestra to develop their musical skills.

The project

That is why we have decided to introduce Syrian culture to the public in the form of concerts, organized in close cooperation with local artists, through this medium of universal communication without borders and preconceived ideas.

Our target audience is, due to the circumstances, a cosmopolitan audience that is rather affluent, sophisticated, open-minded and receptive to new experiences.

The diverse and sophisticated program offered throughout the year by the Cultural Establishment, is a testament to this.

Goal of the project

Our plan is to present our music in Europe and in the whole world, to share it with people and to repeat the experience, keeping the same concept.

A good reputation for a classical musician is priceless. It gives the artist more freedom and presence, with offers to participate in diverse and varied collaborations, and opportunities to perform on stage more often.

This 'popularity' promotes cultural exchange and allows the music to reach a wider audience.

Always with a view of promoting and discovering traditional Syrian and Arabic music, we would also like to integrate new artists from diverse backgrounds who share our values.

One of the most important goals of this project is to preserve the intangible heritage and reach the young Syrian generations who were forcibly displaced their homelands witch cut them off the contact with an important part of their cultural personality.

Composition of the Orchestra

The orchestra consists of 66 artists including the conductor and according to our concept, 6 to 10 of the artists are from the country where the concert will be held on. The choir consists of 20 mixed voices, as well as 3 to 5 Syrian professional singers.

Lubana Al Quntar



Lubana Al Quntar granted the title of the First opera singer in Syria , and named as the first arabic opera and named as the first arabic opera singer to attend opera voice competitions . Her rare voice ability enabled her to sing deferent and wide repertoire between arabic classical songs, folk , traditional, pop and classical opera as a dramatic coloratora. Born in Damascus, Lubana was the first Arab to win the 4the prize at the 1997 International Singing competition

In Belgrade, and the 5th prize at the prestigious Queen Elizabeth singing com-petition in Brussels. Lubana had completed her academic studies at the Royal College of Music in London with Professor Kennith Wollom, and Damascus High institute of Music with Professor Galina Khaldieva, as well as Maastricht Academy of Music in Holland where she studed and granted a degree in Opera singing performance & Music Groups and Associations with Mystra MYA BESSELIK. Lubana has appeared worldwide as a soloist, in Opera and traditional Arabic singing when she always astonished the audience of her ability to variate between the two deferent techniques and improvisation .Notable appearances in- clude: Opera Bastille, Paris; Opera theater La Monnaie, Brussels ; Flamish Opera, Antwerp; Orches- tre philharmonique de liege, Belgium; Flamish Radio Orchestra ; Musica Viva ; Bremen Germany , the world's First arabic Opera "Opera Avincenna" Doha, Qatar; and invited to present her Country in the "Silk Road Festival in Tokyo, Japan. Lubana was invited by the University of California to per- form with the Syrian National Symphony Orchestra ; glyndeborne touring opera performing the Queen Of The Night Lubana was invited by Arab Alliance of women in Music AAWM in Amman "under the auspice of Her Highness, Princess Muna Al-Hussein . Lubana held a position as the Head of the Opera Department at the High Institute of Music in Damascus (2003-2011). Where she taught Opera and Arabic singing techniques. She also was the founder of the Arabic Singing Band consisting of a group of her students and graduates. Currently residing in the Washington DC area dedicating her voice and effort to rise awarness about the syrian cultur ,and helping the refugees around the world through fundraising concerts around the USA.lubana is preparing for her next engagemment at the ROYAL NATIONAL THEATER,LON- DON for salome directed by YAEL FARBER. Lubana is Soloist/choir singer/singing instructor with "Ornina orchestra" since 2018.

Racha Rizk



Born in Damascus Syria, Rasha Rizk began her education of Arabic classical music, at the age of 9, learning a big repertoire of *Mouachahat* and *Qasida* beside theory basics of Arabic music in Rhythm and *Maqamat*. 12 years old, she won the 1st prize of the Young Syrian Pioneers Competition, then she started her musical life performing in concerts and youth festivals . 2002 she graduated from the opera department in the High Institute of Music of Damascus. She graduated from l'Ecole Normale de Musique of Paris with a Diplôme Superieur de Concertiste. She one the fisrt prize of the competition les Clés d'Or in 2016.

Rasha performed many concerts with the Syrian National Symphonic Orchestra and other ensembles, exploring a big repertoire from Baroque music to Italian Bel canto, beside her passion to French and German Art songs.

She played *Suzanna* in Mozart's *Le Nozze di Figaro, Michaela* in Bizet's *Carmen* in Damascus Opera House, *Jumana* in the Arabic opera *Ibn Sina in Doha*, in Pucell's *Dido and Eneas* in Tunis, in Puccini's *Gianni Schicchi*, Nancy in "Oliver Twist", *Amal* in "The Days and Nights of the Heart Tree" an Opera of the French Algérian composer Tarik Benouarka, in which she collaborated in the Arabic adaptation beside another opera of the same composer "Legend of Naram", due to her long experience in the field of Arabic cartoon and TV industry.

Racha is a founding member of the first kids Arabic Channel SpaceToon, with whom she collaborated for almost 20 years as a singer, songwriter and producer, with a huge number of young fans all over the Arab World.

Racha has a remarkable experience in baroque music, after a numerous concerts and recitals in Syria and abroad, where she performed Handel Messiah, Vivaldi's *Gloria*, Pergolese's *Stabat Mater*, and she collaborated with the baroque ensemble *Contrasto Armonico*, with whom she gave many concerts in Damascus and Amsterdam performing a special repertoire from early baroque to Handel Italian Cantatas...

After her exil in France due to the war in Syria, Racha is continuing her concerts in Europe with many Orchestras like the Syrian Expat Philharmonic Orchestra and ORNINA Syrian Orchestra , performing Syrian symphonic compositions, with a great success in the most prestigious concerts Halls like Berliner Konzerthaus, Bremen's Die Glücke, Berlin Philharmonie and Athens Megaron, New Zealand Orchestra with Christian Yärvi.

She recorded many albums and films; "Reborn" and "Era VII" of ERA, with whom she is an international touring 2019-2022, "In memory of Solhi al Wadi", Damascus 2008 with Ziad Rahbani...in "Caramel" and "Now where do we go?" of the Libanese film maker Nadine Labaki. She released her last album "Malak" in March 2017 as a songwriter and arranger, produced by Tarik Benouarka. Rasha is Soloist, singer/singing instructor with "Ornina orchestra" since 2016.
